Airport Security

Checking In

- Have your boarding pass and photo ID in hand.
- Pack lightly and without clutter to facilitate easy screening.
- All liquids, gels, creams and aerosols in your CARRY ON must be in a one quart Ziploc bag.
- Laptops should be stored in your carry on, as they must be removed from your bag and placed into a separate bin for screening.

Carry-on Bag Guidelines

- One quart clear Ziploc bag with all liquids, gels, creams or aerosols in 3 ounce containers or less*
- Maximum dimensions: 22" x 14" x 9"
- One carry-on and one personal item per person.
 - o The personal item must be small enough to fit underneath the seat in front of you.
 - o Personal items include a purse, briefcase, laptop bag, etc.
- Leave a tag with your personal information inside your carry-on.



22" x 14" x 9" or 45 linear inches (including wheels and handle)



All's Well That Ends Well | Allen Elizabethan Theatre

By William Shakespeare | Directed by Tracy Young

When Helena cures an ailing king, he rewards her with the mate of her choosing. She only has eyes for Bertram, but the young man does not return her love. What will become of clever Helena as she navigates this complex comedy of courtships, class, mistaken identities, pain, loss, war and love? With original compositions and

movement, Tracy Young (A Wrinkle in Time, The Imaginary Invalid, The Servant of Two Masters) directs this humorous, inventive and edgy production of Shakespeare's nuanced love story.

Between Two Knees | Thomas Theatre

By the 1941s | Directed by Eric Ting

In this American Revolutions commission, sketch-comedy troupe the 1491s tell an intergenerational story of familial love, loss, and connection that spans the massacre at Wounded Knee, forced reeducation via Indian boarding schools, all of the World Wars so far, the Civil Rights Movement, the terror that was Lawrence Welk, Vietnam and the 1973 takeover at Wounded Knee. Also, it's funny. Directed by California Shakespeare Theater Artistic Director Eric Ting and infused with the 1491s' boldly uninhibited, fearless and subversive approach to comedic storytelling, this world-premiere production takes a hard look at the impacts of systematic oppression after the point that textbooks typically stop teaching Native history. Also, there are nunjas.

By William Shakespeare | Directed by José Luis Valenzuela

Spurred by prophesy and consumed by ambition, Macbeth murders the Scottish king and claims the throne. Fueled by guilt and paranoia, the new king and his wife embark on an increasingly bloody campaign to hold onto power. José Luis Valenzuela (Destiny of Desire) directs "the Scottish play," in which the impulse to destroy rather than change grips the Macbeths, wreaking havoc on their minds and on everyone in their way. Renowned for making the epic feel operatic, Valenzuela's intriguing and ritualistic take on Shakespeare's evocative tragedy

plumbs the depths of human psychology and the pitfalls of unchecked ambition and violence.



Director Rosa Joshi (who helmed 2018's widely praised Henry V) delves into the search for true love in a wondrous world of wit, transformation, and imagination. Exiled from the controlling confines of the court, Duke Senior and her daughter Rosalind seek refuge—and find much more—in the unconstrained Forest of Arden. Also fleeing danger at home, Orlando encounters a young man named Ganymede and seeks help in love—unaware that Ganymede is actually his heart's desire, Rosalind, in disguise. "All the world's a stage" and all society's rules of conformity are off in this exuberant theatrical journey into one of Shakespeare's most beloved comedies.


