Requires an inquest when a law enforcement agent's action, decision or failure to offer appropriate care might have contributed to an individual's death; and provide for legal representation for the decedent's family at county expense |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | <input type="checkbox"/> | Charter Amendment No. 2, Disposition of Real Property for Affordable Housing
Permits the sale of real property at below market value when the property will be used for affordable housing. |

Replace the word "citizen" with the words "public" or "member of the public" in the Preamble and Sections 260 and 800 of the County charter |

Authorizes the Office of Law Enforcement Oversight to subpoena witnesses and documents when investigating actions of county law enforcement officers |

Makes the County Sheriff an appointed position, rather than elected position (as it was prior to 1996) |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | <input type="checkbox"/> | Charter Amendment No. 6, Structure and Duties of the Department of Public Safety
Duties of the county sheriff would be established by ordinance; authorizes the County Council to consolidate the duties of the office with other departments; transfers responsibility for negotiating with law enforcement bargaining units from the sheriff to the County Executive |

Expands the prohibition of discrimination on the basis of being a family caregiver, member of the military, or veteran who was discharged as the result of sexual orientation or gender identity or expression |
