- hats

The most needed food items for the food pantry which serves the children and families through Bailey Gatzert Elementary are:

- 1-2 lbs. bags of rice
- small jars of jelly

- canned green beans
- canned corn

Round 4 of the Small Business Stabilization Fund is Now Live The City of Seattle's Office of Economic Development (OED) has \$2.37 million available funds to provide \$10,000 in grants to small businesses who:

- Are located in Seattle City Limits
- Have up to 25 full-time employees
- Have a net revenue up to \$2 Million
- Have an active Seattle Business License
- Have no more than 2 locations
- Have been in business for at least a year

Businesses who have 5 or less full-time employees will be prioritized and 10% of the grant funds will be set aside for businesses in creative industries. The deadline to apply is Monday, November 30th. You can <u>apply for the grant here</u> and you can <u>learn more specifics here</u>.
